Color Variation

Wood and bamboo are natural materials that feature changes in color and tone. The color variations are more pronounced in some products, less in others. Customers should expect a beautifully variated installation with any of our natural wood products. Wood products have inherently high color variation between plank to plank. This inherent color variation can also be seen within each plank.

If your customer is searching for a more uniform appearance, the Sawatch & Evolution lines are a great option because they are our only flooring lines with low color variance. Sawatch & Evolution do not have the same color variation associated with wood or bamboo floors.




DURABILITY & HARDNESS

The hardness rating of a hardwood floor is the foremost indicator in determining its susceptibility to dings and dents. BHW Floors products are available in a variety of hardnesses which vary based on the manufacturing process, with most being over 3000 on the Janka scale (for comparison, 0ak is around 1350 on the same scale).


All wood flooring is subject to scratches, dings, and dents and bamboo is no exception. However, different types of hardwood floors will wear differently depending on their hardness and type of finish. With proper care, a BHW Floors product can be the longest lasting floor you will ever own.

JANKA HARDNESS TEST

The Janka Hardness Test measures the hardness of a floor by driving a .444 inch (11.28mm) steel ball half of its diameter into the wood. The amount of force required to do this is considered the Hardness Rating. The higher the Janka score, the harder the floor is.

Regardless of whether an item is purchased for home or commercial use, one key consideration involves quality and durability. How long a product lasts before it wears out is an essential part of this perceived quality.

The Taber test is used to measure the resistance of a material to surface abrasion and scratching. This test subjects our flooring finish to years of simulated abrasion and wear. All of our floors pass ASTM requirements for abrasion resistance.

Whereas CARB II standards only measure formaldehyde emissions, FloorScore® standards are much more stringent and measure a wide array of harmful VOC's in addition to formaldehyde.

Basically, the FloorScore® certification means healthier, cleaner air inside your home. When you are floor shopping, choose a product with the FloorScore® label to be assured that your new floor contributes to good indoor air quality.

Warranty Guide Pre-Finished Solid & Engineered Flooring

LIFETIME STRUCTURAL (RESIDENTIAL) WARRANTY

BHW Floors® warrants that our products conform to our strict quality standards and specifications and are free from defects in materials and workmanship and will remain free from such defects for the lifetime of the installed floor.

50-YEAR FINISH (RESIDENTIAL) WARRANTY / 15-YEAR FINISH (LIGHT COMMERCIAL) WARRANTY

BHW Floors® warrants to the original purchaser, that the factory applied surface finish on its prefinished hardwood flooring products will not wear through or separate from the wood for a period of: Fifty [50] years, from the date of purchase, when used under normal residential traffic conditions, or Fifteen [15] years from the date of purchase, when used under light commercial conditions as defined by the NWFA guidelines.

Terms and Conditions

Breach of the following conditions shall render the warranty null and void;

- 1. Warranty must be registered within 30 calendar days of installation of the floor;
- Liability is limited to the original purchase price or cost of repair to affected area(s), subject to the discretion of BHW Floors®;
- Warranty is NON-TRANSFERRABLE;
- Warranty does not apply to any product designated as "Closeout," "AS-IS," "Blowout," "Rustic," "Cabin," "Antique," "Tavern," "B-Grade," "Discontinued," Discounted," or "Clearance";
- The lifetime of the floor is defined as the length of time from installation to resale or from installation to removal, whichever is shorter;
- Installation constitutes acceptance. Bamboo flooring is a natural product, individual planks will vary slightly in color and appearance. The color and appearance of individual samples, panel, and displays may vary slightly from the color and appearance of individual planks;
- 7. The flooring shall be installed according to Manufacturer's written instructions;
- 8. The sub-flooring shall meet or exceed the requirements of the building codes of the local jurisdiction and the recommendations of the National Wood Flooring Association;
- All heating and cooling systems, including radiant heating systems, shall meet or exceed the recommendations of the National Wood Flooring Association;
- 10. The relative humidity of the room where the floor is installed shall be kept between 35% - 55% year-round. The use of a humidifier/dehumidifier may be necessary to maintain this range. DO NOT INSTALL FLOORING IF THESE CONDITIONS ARE NOT CONTINUIOUSLY BEING MET:
- 11. The ambient temperature of the room where the floor is installed shall be kept between 60° F 80° F continuously;

Frequently Asked Questions

HOW ARE BAMBOO FLOORS MADE?

Bamboo poles are split lengthwise, leaving crescent-shaped "splits" of bamboo. These splits are then run through a shaper to give them all a rectangular cross-section and remove the outer skin of the bamboo. These milled splits are then kiln-dried, color selected and laminated together with a hot-press and high-tech Low VOC Adhesives. The resulting planks are then milled in a variety of ways to produce the flooring and panel that suits your needs.

WHAT ARE ENGINEERED FLOORS?

Engineered floors mean that the layers of the floor are "cross-laminated". For example, the grain of the top "wear-layer" runs "North-South". The grain of the middle layer, or "core", runs "East-West" and the grain of the "backing" layer once again runs "North-South".

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF YOUR ENGINEERED FLOORS?

Our engineered floors are made this way to create a floor that has maximum dimensional stability. Once the floor is put together, the force of the various cross-laminated layers averages out to zero. An engineered floor is much less likely to be affected by temperature and humidity changes.

ARE ENGINEERED FLOORS THE SAME AS LAMINATE FLOORS?

Absolutely not! Laminate floors are photographs of wood printed on plastic and glued to a particle board plank. They cannot be re-finished. Scratches and dings often go right through to the particle-board core inviting many problems concerning moisture and longevity.

WHAT IS A "FLOATING" FLOOR?

Engineered floors can be "floated". This means that rather than nailing or gluing the planks to the sub-floor, the boards are edge-glued or clicked together above an underlayment. A floor may be floated above a concrete subfloor, above radiant heat and in condominiums where a nail-down floor is either not possible or not permitted. Other advantages of a floated floor include: less sound travel from the floor above to the living space below (most "walking" sounds you here from the floor above are transmitted through the floor, to the nails, into the joists and out through the ceiling of the floor below). A floated floor expands and contracts as one giant piece, rather than as individual boards.

All of our pre-finished floors are finished with Aluminer. This finishing process yields an extremely durable and abrasion resistant floor.

Formaldehyde is a substance that is naturally present in nearly everything, but the adhesive used in our flooring does not contain any added formaldehyde content. Our formaldehyde levels are less than the existing standard in the USA (CARB II Compliant). In other words, the only formaldehyde that is present in our flooring is there naturally.

HOW DIFFICULT ARE OUR FLOORS TO MAINTAIN?

With today's advances in flooring stains and finishes, cleaning your floor has never been easier. Simply sweep with a soft bristle broom. Clean your floors periodically with a professional floor cleanser, recommended is a prefinished cleaner, such as Bona®. Avoid using any cleaning agents containing wax, oil or polish as left over residue will form a dull film. Do not use vinegar as a cleaning solution; its acidic properties will harm the finish. Minimize abrasive material and dirt by placing mats on both sides of exterior doors and by using area rugs in high-traffic areas. Do not use a steam mop of any kind. Wipe up spills immediately. Do not wax your floor unless it was originally wax finished. Keep pets' nails trimmed. Remove shoes with cleats, spikes or exceptionally pointy heels before walking on the floor. Place protective pads beneath furniture legs and other heavy objects. When moving heavy furniture, do not slide it on the flooring. It is best to pick up the furniture completely to protect the floor from damage.
